NB: Stable Managers hours of operation are: 7am to 7pm

SPLIT DAYS STABLING

If you are booking a stable for one lot of days and then leaving and coming back for another few days, you **MUST** have your stable locked by the Stable Manager or otherwise you will be charged for the number of days it is left unlocked. BEDDING

You may bring your own bedding being Rice Hulls, Straw, Shavings or Sawdust. No bulk deliveries of shavings are allowed. If you are not supplying your own bedding, then each stable will be rented with a minimum of 5 bags of shavings per stable which will be in the stable upon arrival and the cost is \$12 per bag. Additional bags of shavings can be purchased from the Show Office and you will be given a receipt that must be presented to the Stable Manager who will supply you with the number of bags that you have purchased. The Stable Manager will not be able to supply bedding without this docket.

CAMPING

\$20 per day per powered site. Camp sites will be numbered and allocated prior to commencement of 1st show. Requests will be met where possible. If you wish to camp with a friend, we suggest that the camping be sent in together. Sites will not be allocated unless full payment has been received. Preference for South Camping Area will be given to those staying a longer period of time and will be allocated on a first in basis.

Power Leads – Please note that all power leads now need to be tested and tagged. SIEC staff may remove any power leads that are not tagged.

Camping Passes – must be picked up on arrival at grounds. The Pass will state your name, date of arrival & departure. Camping Pass must be attached to the outside of the vehicle which is being hooked up to power, fronting the road for easy access by SIEC representative who every afternoon will be checking the validity of your camping pass. **Please note:** Your camping space is allocated for the float/caravan/gooseneck/tent that you will be camping in. If you are not using your gooseneck and or horse float for camping then they must be parked elsewhere nearby, not at the campsite. There is not enough room on some sites. Camping without power will still be charged camping fees.

As a condition of entry to the SIEC, persons:

1. Agree to follow the direction and instruction of SIEC staff at all times whilst at the SIEC
2. Agree to adhere to all directions displayed on signage at the SIEC
3. Agree they will not do any of the following within the SIEC:
 - a) Use indecent, obscene, insulting or threatening language
 - b) Behave in an offensive or indecent manner
 - c) Ride a horse without a safety helmet and without appropriate clothing and footwear (NOTE: NPHA/SQHA insurance does cover riding without a safety helmet so the part of this rule relating to safety helmets does not apply)
 - d) Light any fire
 - e) Bring or attempt to bring into the SIEC any alcohol or glass without the written approval of the SIEC
 - f) Bring a dog to the SIEC without a lead. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times whilst at the SIEC.
 - g) Take animals into any building at the SIEC
 - h) Leave any personal or animal waste at the SIEC, except if that waste is left in the appropriate bins allocated
 - i) Use any fire hoses at the SIEC. Penalties will apply
 - j) Interfere with or harm any wildlife at the SIEC
 - k) Smoke in or around any SIEC building. All SIEC buildings are smoke free
 - l) Break, damage, deface, obliterate or cover any structure, machinery, equipment, sign, descriptive plate or label.
4. Must comply with all NSW Road Rules and related legislation. All roads are designated public carriage ways and NSW legislation and Road Rules apply. In addition, the following applies:
 - a) only registered vehicles (including motorcycles and four wheel bikes) are permitted to be used at the SIEC
 - b) riders of motorcycles, bicycles and four wheel bikes must wear Australian standard approved helmets at all times
 - c) bicycles or any vehicles must not be used after dark without front and rear lights
 - d) golf carts must have current conditional registration in accordance with RTA legislation. Golf carts are only permitted to carry the specified number of passengers, no overloading will be permitted. Golf carts may only be operated by licensed drivers. Golf carts must not be driven whilst the driver is under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Between sunset and sunrise all golf carts are to be parked in a central location, specified by the SIEC, and keys are to be removed.
